AIRPORT, CRUISE TERMINAL & TRANSFERS INFORMATION

CRUISE CHECK-IN

Begins usually around noon, depending on how the debarkation of the previous cruise goes and up until 3:00 (one hour before sailing). However, you may not be able to go to the cabins until the afternoon. as they will need to finish cleaning them. Usually there is an announcement on board when you can go to your cabin. You can drop your luggage off to the cruise porters once the debarkation process is over.

The Canada Line is a 19 km rapid transit system connecting Vancouver with central Richmond and the Vancouver Airport. With a transit capacity equivalent to 10 major road lanes, it links growing residential, business, health care, educational and other centres in the region. The 16-station line connects with existing rapid transit at Waterfront Station and major east-west transit services elsewhere, creating an enhanced transit network to serve the region. The Canada Line is operated by InTransitBC, an independently-governed subsidiary of TransLink, the organization responsible for regional transportation in Metro Vancouver.

Where You're Docked

The prime location for ships is Canada Place Terminal, which is smack downtown and within a few steps of hotels, restaurants, shopping, and attractions. Getting to the cruise terminal upon arrival is a cinch. The airport is located south of the city, in the neighborhood of Richmond, 14 km (nine miles) from the downtown peninsula.

Curbside porters are available at the pier to take baggage to the vessel for delivery by shipboard personnel to your stateroom. It is customary to tip the porter for this service. Please be advised that the curbside porters are not employees of the cruise line. You are responsible for your belonging at all times.

Estimated cost of a taxi or Uber to the pier from the airport or City Center is approximately \$35 CAD plus tip (12 miles)

END OF CRUISE - DEPARTURE PORT JUNE 20, 2026

Passengers are disembarked in order of earliest flight times off the ship first. The passenger services desk arranges/plans the disembarkation process during the actual voyage, for the end of that voyage. But, usually for the northbound cruises, disembarkation commences at about 6:15 am and ends at about 10 am (so approximately 4 hours long to disembark the ship). This is approximate, depending on customs, security, etc. It is sometimes possible to leave the ship as early as 7:00 am for early flights, or have delayed disembarkation up until 11:00 am. For early or delayed disembarkation please see the information desk on board.

Sundancer always gets luggage tags for our group for the earliest regular disembarkation, and they you are free to disembark at that time or anytime thereafter.

Port of Whittier

There are public washrooms located at the cruise terminal. There are no shops or restaurants inside, but there are a few stores and small cafes within walking distance. Porters are not available at the Whittier Cruise Ship Terminal, but there are luggage carts available for use. Wi-Fi is not available at the cruise terminal.

The Whittier Cruise Ship Terminal is located 60 miles from Anchorage, and about a 90-minute drive southeast of Anchorage. Princess provides a bus shuttle that can be booked through Sundancer. No taxi service is available from Whittier to Anchorage. No local public bus service is available to or from Anchorage.

Local shuttle operators offer either narrated direct transfers or half-day tours on your way down to the port. They pick-up location for all shuttles is outside of the baggage claim at both terminals. This would be a good option if you have a later flight. We will be providing more details later.

A Princess Hospitality Center, located in downtown Anchorage, is utilized for passengers in transit to or from Whittier. The Hospitality Center provides a waiting area, secure (short-term) luggage-storing facilities, and easy access to restaurants and shops. Taxi service from the Hospitality Center to the Airport (7 miles/20 minutes) is approximately \$18.00-\$25.00 per taxi.

PRINCESS BUS SHUTTLE SERVICE

Purchase of transfers can be done through Sundancer up to 10 days prior to your sail date; you will need to provide your flight information at the time of purchase. Flight details are provided to the transportation company to assist in expediting your transfer to the pier. It is your responsibility to update Sundancer with any changes to your flight schedule to ensure you are met by the transportation company.

One Way Vancouver to pier - \$34.00 / person - 1 hours One Way Whittier to Anchorage - \$59.00 / person - 1.7 hours

Transfer rates are subject to change and any unused services are nonrefundable. Sundancer recommends you wait to book this until after your final payment is processed.

When using the Ship's Shuttle Service your flights must:

TO BE CONFIRMED: Arriving - Your flight should arrive before 3:00 p.m, but they suggest by 1:00 to allow time to clear customs Departing - Your flight should depart after 11:00 a.m.
